- A verb may consist of one or more words.
- Auxiliary verbs help the base verb to make tenses, passives and questions.
- The main auxiliary verbs are be, is, am, are, will, have, has and do.

past participle

We add 'ed' to most verbs to form past simple tenses or past participles., eg. clean \Rightarrow cleaned \Rightarrow cleaned For some verbs, the spelling becomes irregular (doesn't follow usual rules). see → saw → seen
